





BACKGROUND: The Los Angeles Marathon, known as the "Stadium to the Sea", is a 26.2-mile race which began at Dodger Stadium at 6:55a.m., went through West Hollywood, Beverly Hills and ended in Santa Monica. On Sunday, March 19, 2017, over 24,000 athletes from all 50 states and more than 63 countries participated and a total of 18,918 completed the Los Angeles Marathon.
