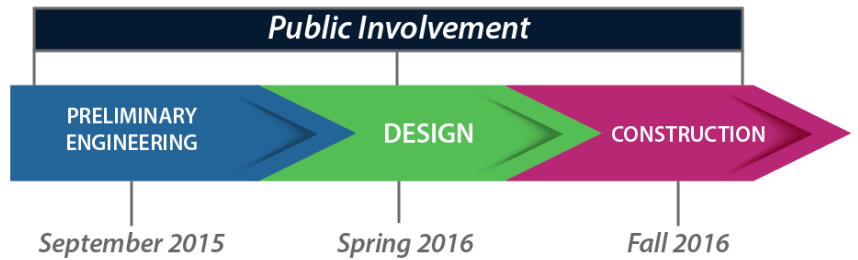
The Firestone Boulevard Regional Corridor Capacity Enhancement Project's objective is to improve one of the major gateways into the City by easing traffic circulation and increasing driver and pedestrian safety. The project will increase the overall number of lanes from four to six on Firestone Boulevard between Alameda Street and Hunt Avenue as well as synchronize traffic signals and add landscaped and hardscaped raised medians along the corridor. Raised medians have demonstrated to be particularly effective at improving traffic movement in areas similar to Firestone Boulevard where there is a mixture of significant pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

The Project is funded by local and state grant funds. Design is anticipated to be complete in Spring 2016 and construction is anticipated to begin in Fall 2016.

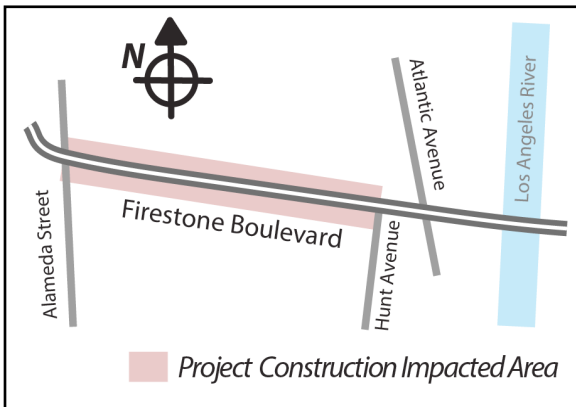


Project Milestones
