UPDATED - CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening over the Los Angeles River

Summary:

Stage I of the Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening project has been completed. This first phase of work included widening the south side of the bridge and placing concrete pavement just east of Rayo Avenue. The next phase of work has been scheduled and will require new temporary traffic controls.

What to Expect:

The contractor will start the second phase of work on **Tuesday April 25**, which entails the removal of the existing asphalt pavement and replacing it with concrete pavement on the north west end of the bridge. A new traffic control set-up will be implemented to accommodate motorists. Traffic lanes will be shifted and will require temporary striping and delineators. Two eastbound travel lanes and two westbound travel lanes will be available to motorists. Temporary traffic controls will remain in place for approximately 3-4 weeks to keep construction on schedule.

The last phase of the project is scheduled to start in June, 2017.

Tips:

Commuters are encouraged to utilize alternate routes to avoid delays. Drive safely near any construction zone. Remember not to use mobile phones while driving, particularly around construction zones.


