**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF SOUTH GATE APPROVING A LOW IMPACT  
DEVELOPMENT TECHNICAL GUIDANCE MANUAL FOR  
SMALL SITES**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit (Order No. R-2012-0175), adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region on November 8, 2012 and becoming effective December 28, 2012, requires all municipalities to implement programs to reduce the amount of pollutants in urban and stormwater runoff; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 28, 2011, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2282 adopting the Los Angeles County's Low Impact Development Manual by reference which requires projects disturbing more than 500 square feet of surface area to implement stormwater treatment controls; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the MS4 permit, Los Angeles County is modifying its Low Impact Development Manual and is no longer expected to be suitable for use within the City of South Gate; and

**WHEREAS**, a Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual for Small Sites has been developed by the Gateway Water Management Authority;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The above recitals are all true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council of the City of South Gate, California, hereby adopts the Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual for Small Sites (Exhibit A).


**SECTION 3.** Reference to the Los Angeles County Low Impact Development Manual is eliminated from the Municipal Code.

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

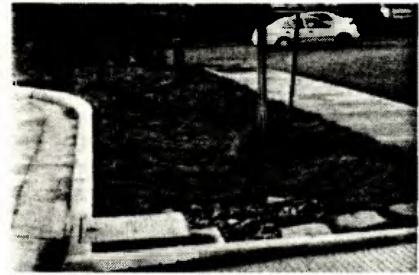
