

Household Hazardous Waste Acceptable Items List

Do you have old cans of paint, pesticides or garden chemicals? Then bring them to the Earth Day event on Saturday, April 22nd.

Residents will need to bring a driver's license or state issued ID card.

Accepted materials include:

- Paint Products: Oil-based paint, latex paint, caulk, glue, stain, stripper, thinner, spray paint, and wood preservative
- Automotive Products- Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels and more
- Garden Chemicals Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides and weed killers
- Household Cleaners: Ammonia, bleach, toilet bowl cleaner, heavy-duty cleansers, tile and shower cleaners, rust remover and strippers
- Household Batteries- any size
- Compact Fluorescent Lamps and straight fluorescent Tubes
- Mercury containing items: Thermometers and thermostats

NOT acceptable:

- Ammunition and explosives
- Electronics Items
- Tires
- Trash
- Large appliances such as refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, etc.
- Asbestos
- Items in leaking or unlabeled containers
- Unknown items
- Vehicle batteries
- No materials from businesses
- Syringes, needles and lancets
- Medicines and prescriptions

Getting your items ready:

This is a cleanup program for residents of South Gate only. Businesses are not allowed to bring unwanted materials to this event.

- All items must be easily identifiable
- Must be in sealed, labeled, non-leaking containers of 5 gallons or less
- There is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of material per vehicle
- Do not mix chemicals together
