CONSTRUCTION ALERT UPDATE

Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening over the Los Angeles River

Summary:

Stage II of the Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening project is nearing completion. This work included the removal of existing asphalt on the northerly section of the bridge and construction of new concrete pavement. The next phase of work has been scheduled and will require new temporary traffic controls.

What to Expect:

The contractor will start the Stage III work on Wednesday night, May 24. Work entails the removal of the existing asphalt pavement from the center section of the bridge and construction of new concrete pavement. A new traffic control set-up will be implemented to accommodate construction. Traffic lanes will be shifted and will require temporary striping and delineators. Two eastbound travel lanes and two westbound travel lanes will be available to motorists.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE WESTBOUND LEFT TURN LANE ONTO RAYO AVENUE WILL BE CLOSED DURING THIS PHASE OF CONSTRUCTION. A detour will be setup for motorists and trucks to access Rayo Avenue. These Temporary traffic controls will remain in place for approximately 3-4 weeks to keep construction on schedule.

Tips:

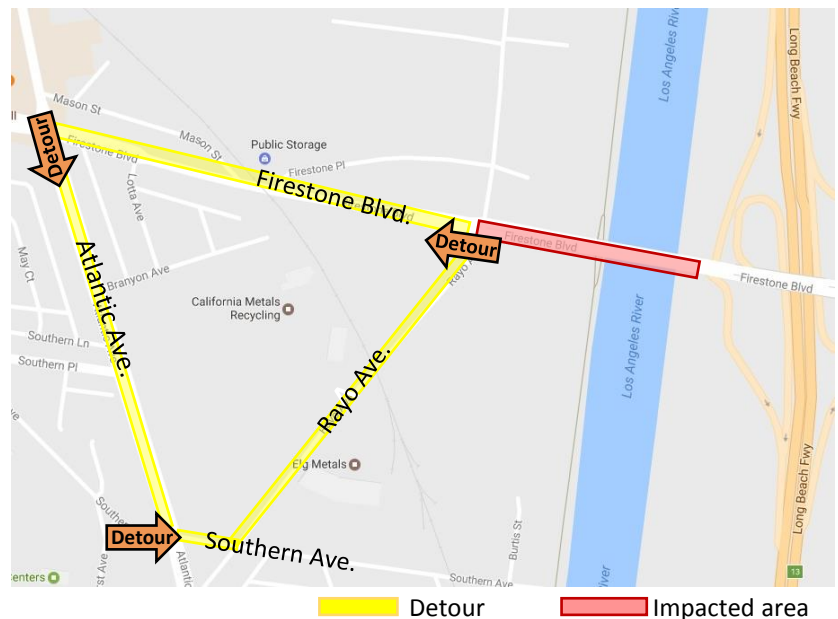
