CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Elizabeth Reservoir, Booster Station, Well No. 28 and 29, at the Santa Fe Tank Site Project

Summary:

The City of South Gate continues its efforts to enhance the reliability of the City's Water System. As part of this project, the old existing waterline along California, San Luis and Ardmore Avenues were replaced and now the contractor will be resurfacing the affected roadways.

What to Expect:

Starting Monday, July 17, the Contractor will be repaving San Luis Avenue (Firestone Blvd. to Ardmore Ave.); California Avenue (Glenn T Seaborg Way to Liberty Blvd.) and Ardmore Avenue (California Ave. to Otis St.).

No parking signs will be posted along impacted streets. California Avenue will maintain one lane open in each direction at all times. Ardmore Avenue and San Luis Avenue may be intermittently closed from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm. This work is expected to be complete by Friday, July 21.

A Safety Message:

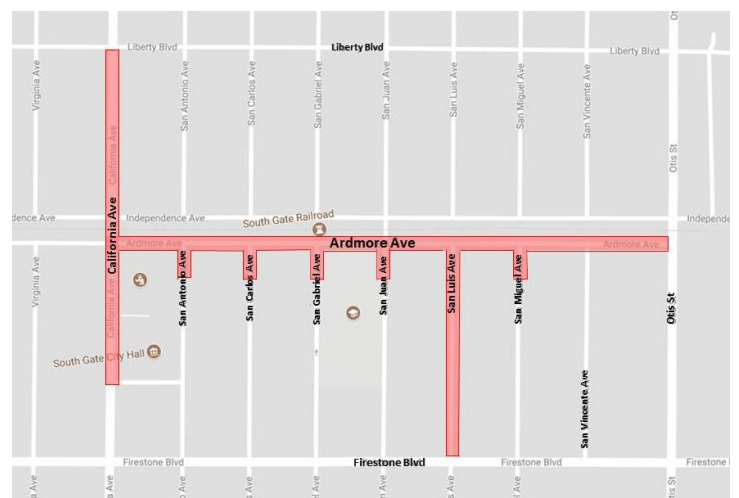
